WEDDING FAQs

What is included in my wedding package?

The Wedding Package of \$4,500 includes complimentary food tasting for four, rehearsal space, fruit infused water station (summer) or hot chocolate and cider station (winter) before ceremony, mahogany folding chairs with black pad for ceremony, sound system with (1) wireless microphone, mahogany chiavari chairs with white cushions for the reception, eloquently set round tables with floor length cream linens with light cappuccino overlay and votive candles, personalized menu cards, dance floor, staging, easels, gift table and complimentary 1 bedroom suite for bride and groom on wedding night. Preferred discount pricing for guestrooms is also available.

Can we “hold” the space while we make our decision?

A three day temporary hold will be placed on your function space once a proposal has been prepared. Upon receiving the contract, you will have seven days to return the entire signed copy of the contract along with the deposit for your wedding.

What deposits are required?

An initial deposit of \$5,000 is due upon signing of a catering contract. The advance deposit structure is based on the combined Food & Beverage minimum and room rental for the event(s), plus service charge and sales tax. Final payment is required one month prior to the event date along with a completed credit card authorization form so we have a form of payment on file should there be a remaining balance at the conclusion of your event. Any remaining balance will be charged to the credit card on file the next business day after event(s). Please note all deposits are non-refundable.

What is a Food & Beverage minimum?

The Food & Beverage minimum is the amount required to spend for your event. It is calculated based on all food and beverage purchased for your event and does not include sales tax or gratuity. It is a minimum commitment and does not imply total cost of your event.

What is the average Food & Beverage cost per person?

Average Food & Beverage costs average \$225 per person. Actual cost is based on menu selection and beverage consumption.

Are any bartenders or servers included in the fee?

Additional staff may be arranged for your event. Bartenders are \$200 each for first two hours and \$75 per hour after. Personal chefs required for carving or actions stations are an additional \$250 each. Coat Check and Restroom Attendants can be added at a flat rate of \$150 per attendant. Overtime charges may apply for any event longer in duration than five hours.

Do you offer tastings for wedding menus?

We provide complimentary tastings for up to four people for events with a \$15,000 and above Food & Beverage minimum. Guests will choose (6) canapés, (2) salads, (3) plated entrees and (3) flavors of cake from Deer Valley Bakery. Before securing any flight arrangements, please let your catering sales manager know of potential dates that you would like to do a tasting. Tastings are scheduled based on availability with our executive chef's schedule. Chef plays an integral part in the tasting and availability is based around hotel operational commitments. Unavailable times are holiday/special weeks such as Christmas to New Year's, Sundance, President's Week, Spring Break and Easter.

How long before an event can we have access to the reception to add décor, etc.?

We allow three hours prior to an event for set-up depending on the use of the space prior to your function. If extra time is necessary and the space is available, you and your vendors are welcome to set-up earlier. However, if you need to guarantee an early set-up time a rental fee may apply. Should your event require additional power, such as a band “power drop,” please inquire with your catering manager for pricing.

Are there any noise restrictions?

Deer Valley has an outdoor noise ordinance – all outdoor music must conclude by 11:00pm due to noise travelling through the mountains. Some groups choose to move into the Astor Ballroom to continue their fun indoors. Another option is to move to the St. Regis Bar, though we cannot guarantee privacy. DJ music is allowed at the bar.

Where should wedding guests park if they are not staying at the resort?

Wedding parking for non-registered guests is available for \$10 per vehicle at Lower Resort only. The lot across from Lower Resort is for Deer Valley Resort and is not part of the hotel.

What if I am checking in on the same day of the wedding into my suite?

Check-in is at 4:00pm. Due to our demand, you may not be able to get into a suite prior to 4:00pm. We highly recommend securing an additional night the day before, allowing more time to get ready and relax in the comfort of the Bridal Suite without having to move items on the wedding day.

What time is check-out?

Check-out is at 12:00pm. Due to our demand, late check-outs are based on availability.

Do you offer additional events besides the ceremony and reception?

Yes. We offer a full array of options for Welcome Receptions, Rehearsal Dinners, Bridal Luncheons and Farewell Brunches that can be held at a number of unique settings within the hotel.

Can I bring in my own hair and make-up team?

Absolutely. Please see our vendor page for recommended stylists and make-up artists. As our spa does not have hair and make-up capabilities, many brides choose to visit our Remède Spa for manicures and pedicures, and then retire to the Bridal Suite to have these specialists create their magic.

How do I secure our wedding license?

You can easily obtain a marriage license at the Summit County Clerk’s office in nearby Coalville. There is no waiting period before you can get married; however, marriage licenses are only valid within 30 days of issuance.

You will need the following to apply for a marriage license:

- Both parties must be present at the time of application
- Full names, addresses and date and place of birth of both parties
- The social security card of both parties, unless a party doesn't have a social security number
- The names and birth places of the parents of both parties, including mother's maiden name
- Valid picture ID such as a passport, birth certificate, driver’s license, or state ID card
- A \$50 license fee (cash, check and credit cards accepted)
